Pricing is valid for 15 days of receiving this contract. Once contract is signed by both parties and deposit is received, pricing is guaranteed. Given that cattle are a commodity market, we can only guarantee pricing for a 15-day period. This protects both us and the client from market volatility as it allows us to lower price or increase price as market dictates. In all cases, we will work closely with the client to insure full transparency.

AGE

Average age of beef recipients is approximately 3–6 years of age and will be polled and composed primarily of continental and british breeds. Brahman and dairy breeds will be avoided. Uniquely, we also offer a qualified recip heifer option as well. On occasion, VICCI will offer quality 7- and 8-year-old recipient cattle that will be offered to clients on a case-by-case basis at discounted rates (prices provided below).

SCREENING

VICCI Cattle Co. offers health-qualified recipient cows chosen for top health status, body condition, and screened for behavior. However, cattle may still act unpredictably in different environments.

Our health testing includes BVD, repro tract scoring, and pelvic measurements.

- All other disease testing must specifically be requested paid for at the client's expense. BVD is the only disease within Oklahoma where management practices can successfully fully mitigate transmission. All other common diseases are impossible to fully prevent, even with best management practices.

Note: No screening test is 100% accurate. Disease status may change with age, exposure, or stress. For example, recipients tested negative for anaplasmosis upon arrival, may later test positive after ET only 90 days later. and In addition, recipients are visually evaluated daily for structural soundness, general health, and any ailments that could affect productivity. Animals that are wild or aggressive are removed from the program.

We maintain an extensive herd health program designed to mitigate risks inherent in commingled cattle. We strongly recommend consulting with your veterinarian to develop a risk management plan for your herd.

VACCINATIONS & PARASITIC TREATMENTS

Recipients are vaccinated and dewormed with the following protocol:

- 3 SolidDose Autogenous Vaccines (ie., Red Label-PE/FR, Purple Label-BRD, Yellow Label-Enteric.) & Blackleg vaccine. Depending on availability, other equivalent/comparable vaccines will be substituted.
- Recipients are dewormed using rotating chemicals at our veterinarian's discretion.

TIMELINE

1. Place orders and pay deposit for implanting frozen/fresh embryos well in advance of desired implant dates to ensure recipient availability.
2. Recipients are typically (but not always) confirmed pregnant with client embryos at 30 days of gestation.

3. At 60 days, pregnancy is reconfirmed and fetal sex determined. At this time, the client will be billed for the pregnant recipient. Payment is required prior to pickup.
4. Boarding fees begin at 70 days of gestation.
5. Clients are responsible for transportation. Clients must contact VICCI Cattle Co. at least 48 hours in advance to arrange pickup and allow time for health papers.
6. VICCI Cattle Co. guarantees recipients to be 60 days pregnant. Insurance is available beyond this point (coverage options to calf age at 14, 30, or 90 days).
7. Recipients must be paid for before they are released.

PREGNANT RECIPIENT POLICY

- VICCI Cattle Co. confirms recipients pregnant at 60 days of gestation. At this point, it is the client's responsibility to pay for and transport recipients as soon as possible.
- Boarding begins at Day 70 of gestation.
- If a recipient comes open before 100 days and remains at VICCI Cattle Co., full credit of purchase price will be issued (less a \$75 set up fee and boarding costs).
- If a recipient comes open after 100 days and remains at VICCI Cattle Co., credit will only be issued for the cow's value as a recipient (determined by OKC market prices).
- If a recipient comes open within 30 days of leaving our facility and prior to 100 days of gestation, credit will be given for the difference between purchase price and sale barn value (less a \$75 set up fee).
- Requires: sale barn receipt, signed veterinarian statement confirming open status, and recip's bangs tag.
- If a recipient leaves after 100 days of gestation or has been in the client's possession longer than 30 days, no refund/credit is issued.
- Credits/refunds only apply if the client's account is current.
- We strongly encourage clients to re-confirm pregnancy status within 30 days of pickup.

OPTION 1 – TRADITIONAL COMMERCIAL RECIPIENT OPTION (\$4,850 ALL-IN PRICE + \$75 transfer fee)

- A deposit of \$500/recipient secures the recipient and provides price protection. In the event a recipient is unavailable or a pregnancy isn't confirmed, the deposit for those animals will be deducted from the final 60-day bred recipient payment.
- Volume discounts available starting at 25 or more.
- \$4,850 for bred 3-6 yo recipient **cow** at 60 days, fetal sexed. Older cows (7-8 yo) will be \$4,350.
- \$5,050 for bred commercial large-framed pelvic measured **heifer** recipients at 60 days, fetal sexed.
- \$75 transfer fee and 2x \$8 ultrasound fees – billed by our repro-vet New Life Veterinary Services separately.

OPTION 2 – DISCOUNTED RECIPIENT PURCHASE PROGRAM (\$4,550 ALL-IN PRICE + \$75 transfer fee)

Overview: Under this option, clients may elect to provide a larger deposit to secure recipient cattle directly from VICCI Cattle Company ("VICCI") prior to embryo transfer at a discounted rate.

Payment Structure and Process (\$4,550 all in price + \$75 transfer fee)

- The client shall pay \$3000/head as a deposit for each qualified recipient, payable upfront.

- VICCI will confirm pregnancy status and determine fetal sex approximately 60 days post-transfer.
- Upon confirmation of pregnancy, the client shall remit an additional \$1,550 per pregnant Recipient.
- Any Recipient that fails to establish pregnancy or dies while under VICCI's care prior to confirmation will be credited in full toward the final balance owed by the client.
- \$75 transfer fee 2x \$8 ultrasound fees – may be billed by New Life Veterinary Services separately.
- Discounted Heifer option is \$4,750/head. In all cases, heifer pricing is \$200/head more than cow pricing.

Ownership and Risk

- Title and risk-of-loss transfer to the client **upon** 60 day pregnancy confirmation and payment of the additional \$1,550 balance. The risk-of-loss policy will mirror that of Option 1.
- Until pregnancy confirmation, VICCI retains possession, care, risk-of-loss and management responsibility for the Recipients.

ACCOUNTING & FUND MANAGEMENT

- Deposit funds shall be used exclusively for:
 - The purchase of VICCI recipient cattle; and/or
 - The onboarding, health screening, and qualification process for such cattle.
- For each Recipient purchased, VICCI will assign a unique ear tag number and electronic identification (EID) and provide the client with a Recipient Assignment List once as the animals are confirmed bred.
- VICCI shall have 90 days from payment date to source, qualify, and assign Recipients to the client.
 - If VICCI is unable to assign qualified Recipients within this period, and no written extension is agreed upon, VICCI shall refund the purchase amount to the client in full.
- Following pregnancy confirmation, any Recipients determined to be open (not pregnant) shall:
 - Be credited toward the total amount owed by the client (less a \$75 set up fee); and
 - May be recycled or retired from the recip program at VICCI's discretion.
- VICCI will provide the client with an updated Recipient Ownership List reflecting only the confirmed pregnant Recipients following final pregnancy confirmation.
- **EXCESS CREDITS:** Any client credit balance remaining after final billing—defined as original deposits exceeding total charges, even after application to reduce the balance to \$0—will be refunded within 60 days of the final pregnancy check and billing. Refunds will be issued via priority mail or wire transfer.

BOARDING POLICY (FOR BOTH OPTIONS 1 & 2)

- If client intends to pick up recip after preg confirmation, boarding fees begin at day 70 at \$8/day.
- If planned in advance, and the client wishes to keep the confirmed bred recip with VICCI for greater than 30 days, but less than or equal to 90 days, then VICCI will charge \$4.50/day/animal to board.
- If planned in advance, and the client wishes to keep the confirmed bred recip with VICCI for greater than 90 days but less than 250 days gestation, then VICCI will charge \$3.50/day/animal to board.
- If planned in advance, and the client would prefer VICCI to custom graze, calve, and wean the recipient and her ET calf then the pricing will be:
 - \$2.40/recip/day without creep (notable volume discounts available starting at 25 recips)
 - \$2.85/recip/day with creep (notable volume discounts available starting at 25 recips)

- All boarding or custom grazing options start on day 70.

New Life Veterinary Services provides **basic liability coverage** for embryos stored within our facility. This coverage is **limited in scope** and is intended only to protect against direct negligence on the part of New Life Veterinary Services. This policy **does not** cover the market value of embryos.

Clients should be aware of the following limitations:

- 1. Exclusions from Coverage**
 - Coverage does **not** extend to losses resulting from mechanical or electrical failure of storage tanks, power outages, natural disasters, or other unforeseen events.
 - Coverage does **not** insure the potential or projected future value or earnings of embryos stored.
 - Coverage does **not** apply to causes outside the direct control of New Life Veterinary Services.
- 2. Client Responsibility**
 - Clients are strongly encouraged to obtain their own comprehensive insurance coverage for stored embryos. This may include policies that insure the genetic or market value of embryos, as well as coverage against tank failure or catastrophic loss.
 - Clients acknowledge that embryo storage and handling carries inherent risks and accept responsibility for securing appropriate independent protection.
- 3. Tank Monitoring and Maintenance**
 - All storage tanks are checked and maintained on a **regular schedule** to verify proper performance and nitrogen levels.
 - While every effort is made to ensure reliability, New Life Veterinary Services **cannot guarantee** that tanks will not fail, malfunction, or experience performance issues.

1. Conception Rates and Outcomes

- No guarantee of conception, pregnancy rate, or live calf outcome is made or implied.
- Conception rates may be influenced by numerous factors outside of our control, including but not limited to: recipient animal condition, environment, nutrition, stress, semen or embryo quality, and individual biological variability.
- Synchronization protocols and embryo transfer procedures are performed in accordance with, or in many cases exceeding, **established industry standards** and veterinary best practices.

2. Animal Handling and Welfare

- All staff responsible for animal care and handling are trained in **Beef Quality Assurance (BQA)** standards and protocols.
- Cattle are managed in a **low-stress handling facility** specifically designed to reduce stress and ensure safety for both animals and personnel.
- Practices are reviewed regularly to maintain compliance with recognized standards.

3. Nutrition and Herd Health

- All animals in our care receive adequate and balanced nutrition, including access to **high-quality hay, feed, minerals, and salt**.
- Veterinary oversight is provided on an as-needed basis, including treatment, vaccination, and herd health protocols to safeguard animal well-being.
- Preventive health programs and nutritional supplementation are implemented to support optimal reproductive performance and overall herd condition.
